All students have access to the standard curriculum which is free.

Examples include student magazine, music lessons, school camps.

If parents/ guardians are eligible for the Camps Sports and Excursion funding (CSEF), the school will apply this money towards any charges marked * on this schedule. Application forms are available at the General Office or download the form from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef. A parent or guardian must be the holder of a current concession card to be eligible.

As most of the College's text books and curriculum materials are now accessed online, parents are required to pay either a netbook service fee (if using the College's netbook fleet) or a bring your own device (BYOD) fee to cover costs of software, online texts, printing credit and technical support.
