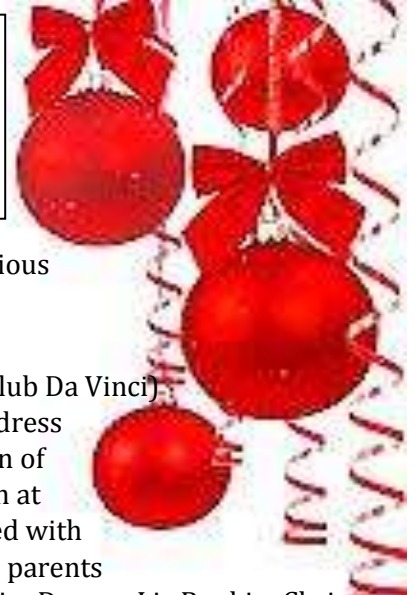
The past week has been very busy with various End-Of-Year College Functions being held including:

YEAR 7 UNIFORM PACKAGE INITIATIVE 2016 **A STATE SCHOOL'S RELIEF PROGRAM**

Every Year 7 government school student enrolled in 2016 who is a recipient of the Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) automatically qualifies for a free uniform pack to the approximate value of \$225.

The 2015 CSEF recipients can apply for a pack from 1st December 2015 from the school office.

Included in the Uniform Pack are basic items.

***Jumper x 1, PE shirt x 1, PE shorts x 1.
For girls a dress (or shorts or trousers) x 1
and a shirt x 1 (long or short sleeve).***

***For boys a shirt x 1 (long or short sleeve)
and shorts or trousers x 1.***

When a family application has been approved a voucher will be sent to the school and then given to the family. The voucher is valid for 75 days only. Parents who missed this year's CSEF applications or were ineligible in 2015, can apply in 2016.

Notification about applications will be advertised very early next year via the school newsletters.

BE SUNSMART

The UV levels in this area are regularly above safe levels during Term 1 and 4. It is a policy in our school that students are to protect themselves if they are expecting to be exposed to direct sunlight for more than fifteen minutes on days when the UV rating is above safe levels. Their personal protection can be in the form of clothing and sunscreen. We encourage students to apply sunscreen at home at the beginning of the day. If they need to top up their application they can bring sunscreen to school and lock it securely in their school provided locker. The policy also states that students should avoid prolonged exposure to UV radiation when possible. The school encourages students to stay out of direct sunlight by opening the air-conditioned buildings for students to use at lunchtimes on days of extreme heat.
